SimpleShortcuts Excel Add-In is a free Excel add-in that helps people quickly and easily format spreadsheets using easy to remember customizable hotkey keyboard shortcuts.

Auditing Controls <i>(Ctrl+Shift+)</i>							
	Auto Auditing	Automatically trace dependents and/or precedents while working in worksheet.					
	Smart Trace Dependents	Cycle through the direct dependents of the selected cell.					
	Smart Trace Precedents	Cycle through the direct precedents of the selected cell.					
Advanced Controls <i>(Ctrl+Shift+)</i>							
F	Copy Cell Across	Copies the selected cell across a range based on the populated cells above the selection.					
Y	Load Custom Colors	Adopts the saved custom color palette.					
	Save Current Colors	Sets SimpleShortcuts' default color palette to the current color palette.					
Q	Prepare New Worksheet	Applies standard formatting to the current selected sheet and prepares for printing.					
W	Prepare Excel	Turns on iteration, sets calculation to automatic except tables, adopts custom color palette.					
I	Wrap IF ISERROR "n/a"	Wraps the current formula in a selected cell with =IF(ISERROR([existing formula]),"n/a",[existing formula]).
